On 15th November, 2009, our club organised a major eye checkup camp at Jangul Sufi, Belgachhia with the help of Dr. Rajani Rampuria & her team. The checkup started at 9 am and was scheduled to continue upto 4 pm. But, the time was inadequate for the large number of patients who had come from far away villages. By the time the camp concluded, it was past 7 pm and a record number of 1035 patients had their eyes checked up. More than 400 free spectacles were given to the needy patients. Over 125 cataract patients were detected. All the patients with cataract problems are being operated upon free of cost at Eye pavillon, the clinic of Dr. Rajani Rampuria.

# ■ A proud Moment for Renu Dalmia & Archana Salarpuria



On 12th November, 2009, the Department Of Posts, India, released a First Day Cover and a commemorative postage stamp on Freedom Fighter - GAURISHANKER DALMIA. We at IWCCC are very happy as he was Renu Dalmia's Dadaji-in-law and also Archana Salarpuria's Nanaji-in-law.

#### A Few lines on Gaurishankar Dalmia

- Gaurishanker Dalmia was born on 12/11/1910 at Lakhisaray village in Munger district, Bihar.
- Responding to the call of Mahatma Gandhi, he abandoned his family business and joined the freedom struggle in 1926.
- He was improsoned in 1931 for participating in the "Namak Satyagrah".
- He was elected as Member of Bihar Legislative Assembly (MLA) from 1937 till 1952 and Member of Bihar Legislative Council from 1952 to 1972.
- He was associated with many business and educational institutions, like FICCI, Bhagalpur University, Indian Employers Association, Bihar Industries Association.
- He was the founder President of the South Bihar Chamber of Commerce and remained so for 20 years.
- He was especially interested in the fields of Education and Health, involving himself
  in work relating to education, leprosy eradication, rehabilitation of handicapped
  persons, upliftment of Adiwasis (aboriginal tribes), Prakritik Chikitsa (Nature
  Cures).
- He also published weekly magazines "Prakash" in hindi and "The Spark" in english for two decades.
- He passed away on 16/6/1988.
