## Donations at UNMISH

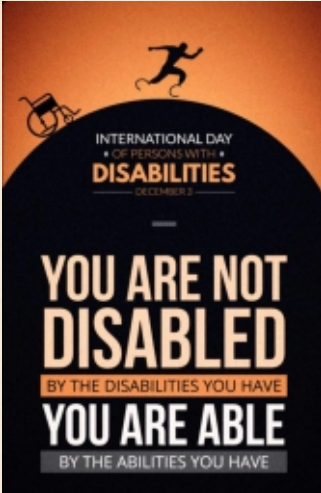

## DAY6

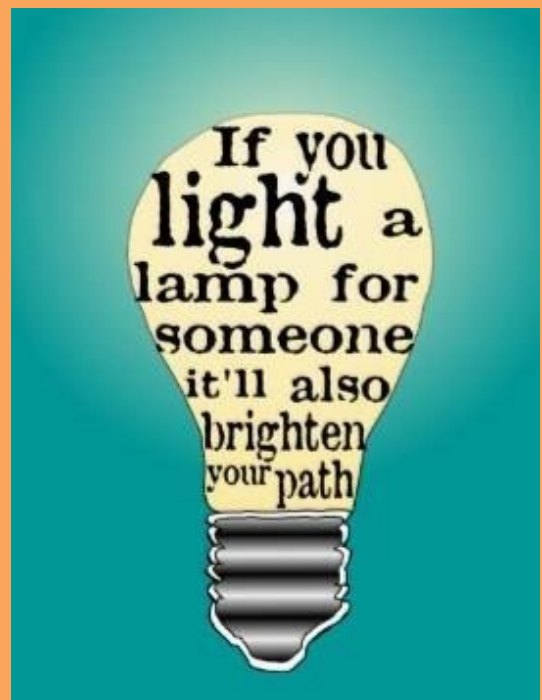
