"Apnalaya"- Our dream Project .....


I love to dream with open eyes and nurture them. And when I dream, I recollect the following lines of a poem:

## An Ascending saga:

Inner Wheel Club of Central Calcutta began its journey on 17<sup>th</sup> March 1989, with 36 charter members, receiving its charter on 14<sup>th</sup> June 1989. With a healthy foundation like this the club went on to add many member it its fold and today has more than 60 members. It created many milestones in the first year of its existence and since then there has been no stopping to an ascending saga in the last 21 years.

On the way up we did many meaningful projects, upgrading ourselves every time. Innovative and complete fun programs were designed for the members, which kept the spirit alive in the club. Earlier there used to be annual schemes of the club, which after successful implementation became regular features. Programs like Fashion Show by the members, Lay the table contest, Kolkata Kite Karnival and service projects like donation of expensive equipments to the hospitals, ambulances, making class room and libraries were inventive and benefitted many lives. The club went on to buy a land for a permanent project all by itself in 2006. Today, we have a project, namely APNALAY, which will be there for times to come (if things move according to the vision) and which has given us an unprecedented confidence as far as social work is concerned.

Today some of our key programs and projects are:

PROGRAMS: TEMPTATIONS, TEMPTATIONS PLUS, FASHION QUOTIENT- all fund raising events, ECHO- our annual souvenir, HUSBANDS' NITE- a fun filled evening for our spouses, CHARTER DAY- a fellowship program for the members and invitees of sister clubs, JUMBLE SALE-sale of old things.

PROJECTS: APNALAY- a home for senior citizens, being under construction, CLEFT LIP/ CLEFT PALATE surgical correction for the needy, EYE CARE- under which 1200 patients were checked up, 800 spectacles were distributed free of cost and 30 patients were operated for the cataract, EDUCATION/SCHOOL- refurbishing of a school roof

An Institution in the Making

When Rotary Club of Central Calcutta was being founded, in 1983, the founding members would little have imagined that the new Rotary club would go on to become a leading light of district 3290/3291, that it would travel with so much dedication on the path towards the Rotary ideal of Service Above Self, and that its activities and projects would closely touch so many lives along the way.

The club has sponsored several active Interact clubs, a **Rotaract club**, six RCCs, not to speak of its most precious asset, namely the **Inner Wheel club**, which has blossomed into a leader in its own right.

Included in the service programmes of the club are low-cost homes for the homeless in rural areas, sanitary latrines, deep tube wells, soak pits, rain water harvesting, village roads, IOL implants, artificial limbs, scholarships, health care, heart surgeries, polio immunisation, and so much more.

One can well imagine how many lives have been touched by these programmes which have been going on for 25 years. It has been a source of satisfaction and encouragement for the members to see how its efforts have resulted in alleviating the problems of the community.

# DEBATE ON PARENTS SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHT TO CHOOSE THE GENDER OF THEIR OFFSPRING

Our for the Motion team comprised of Sunita, Dipti, Mridu & Shruti where their strong points were: --

- 2) Certain diseases are carried from male to male child only, eliminates abnormalities, deformities disorders allows healthy babies.
- 3) Provides happiness to educated parents who are then able to choose and shop for the sex of the child. It thus helps the girl-boy balance in the family.
- 4) Eliminates immoral acts like murder killing by obnoxious methods e.g. sand, tobacco juice, towels etc.
- 5) The unwanted girl child is saved the misery of growing up neglected and scarred for life.

The points against the motion were put forward by Anjana, Sarla, Mona & Deepa

- 1) It was unethical, discriminatory. Why should society wants sons only?
- 2) It goes against equal rights for sexes and society is not imbalanced with children of the same sex to a parent.
- 3) Gender selection will result in demographics imbalances; we don't need to play God.
- 4) Sex selection is an unnatural, medical procedure, which are for medical purpose only.
- 5) Evils of society would rise with more males than females e.g. polyandry, prostitution, sex related crimes.

We had Anuja Kumar, a psychologist counselor and Human resource consultant as the Judge who balanced the debate by giving her valuable points on the issue.

She concluded the debate by saying there were evident advantages to a gender selection as it eliminates a lot of atrocities against the girl child. But India as a country was not ready for it. It would give equal rights to the rich – poor, educated – uneducated, upper – lower class. Our society is ridden by poverty, uneducated masses, immaturity, superstitions etc hence such a tool cannot be given to our society. We would not be leaving behind a good legacy as well.

It is better to be a contended mother of a happy child. Children were to be valued as they were born.
